We have been working with both DMS and edtec to plan for a smooth transition. This effort continues. We will work with edtec in parallel to develop the budget to be presented in June.

Senate Bill-739

UPDATED: An amendment to the Education Code is in process relating to renewals of charters. This legislation includes an extension of the requirement to provide evidence of growth using verified data (such as i-Ready). One additional element in this amendment would provide for another two year a one-year extension to current expiration of charters. That potentially would extend our term from 6/30/26 to 6/30/28 6/30/27 and give us additional time to show improvement!

PROPERTY INQUIRY

I inquired about a 2-acre property near the Doyle campus and learned the owner is seeking \$150,000.00 Nick Trover suggested we might want to explore adjacent properties that could potentially serve as a parking lot.

SUMMARY NARRATIVE

This report is intended to provide a financial update comparing the First Interim Budget with actuals through March 31, 2023. Along with an update on the financial health of the organization, these updates are a means to review and detect coding and budgeting issues and to make corrections throughout the year. Reviewing and collaborating together on a regular basis to thoughtfully address these issues, especially early in the year, are the the key to successful financial reporting.

Expenditures appear to be right on target as compared to Second Interim Budget projections. At this point with 75% of the year (9 months) completed, compensation and benefits are on track. Some of the "front-loading" effect is still present in supplies and services overall but should be stabilizing as the months go by.

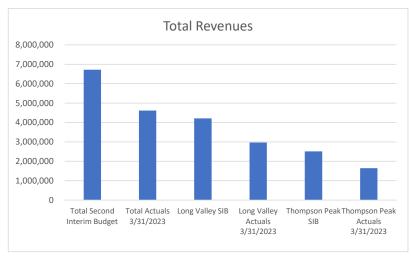
Revenues received continue to trailing behind what would be expected on a monthly basis; however, in total the revenues are beginning to come closer to budget as well. It is important to continue to keep in mind that state and federal revenues do not flow evenly throughout the year; therefore, YTD results are not a valuable measure of the financial performance. Current year revenues are subject to change next month.

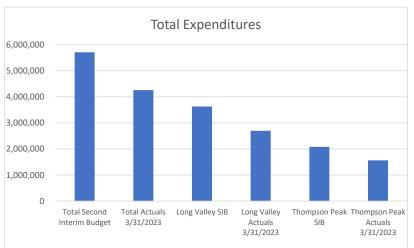
For Cash Flows, Long Valley School is projected to the end the year with 242 days cash on hand representing 66% of annual expenditures. Thompson Peak Charter is projected to the end the year with 277 days cash on hand representing 75% of annual expenditures. In addition, the Cash Flow for Long Valley net inflows/outflows is reflecting the recognition of the Doyle Property acquisition which closed escrow this month.

Long Valley School and Thompson Peak Charter continue to demonstrate fiscal stability and improving reserves and are projected to meet all obligations as scheduled. DMS will continue to monitor the political and economic landscape to anticipate potential fiscal impacts.

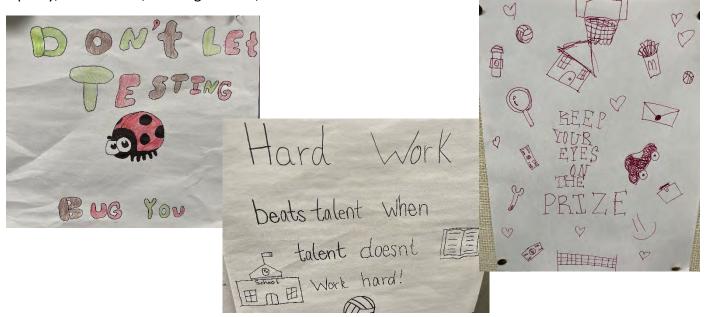

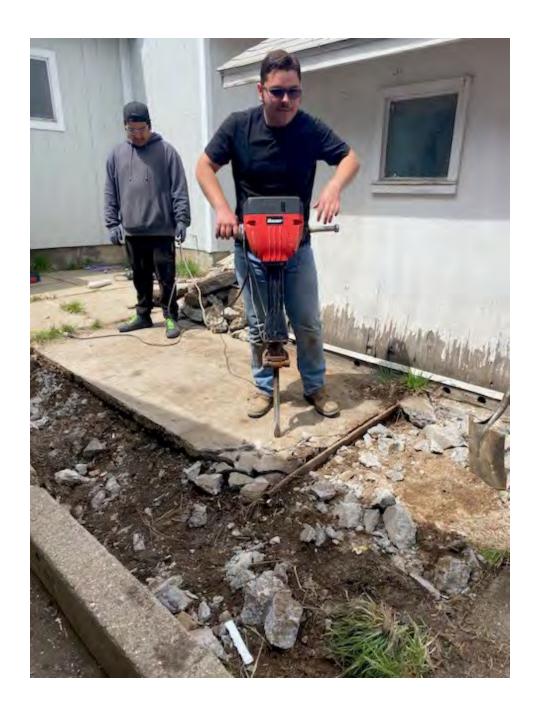

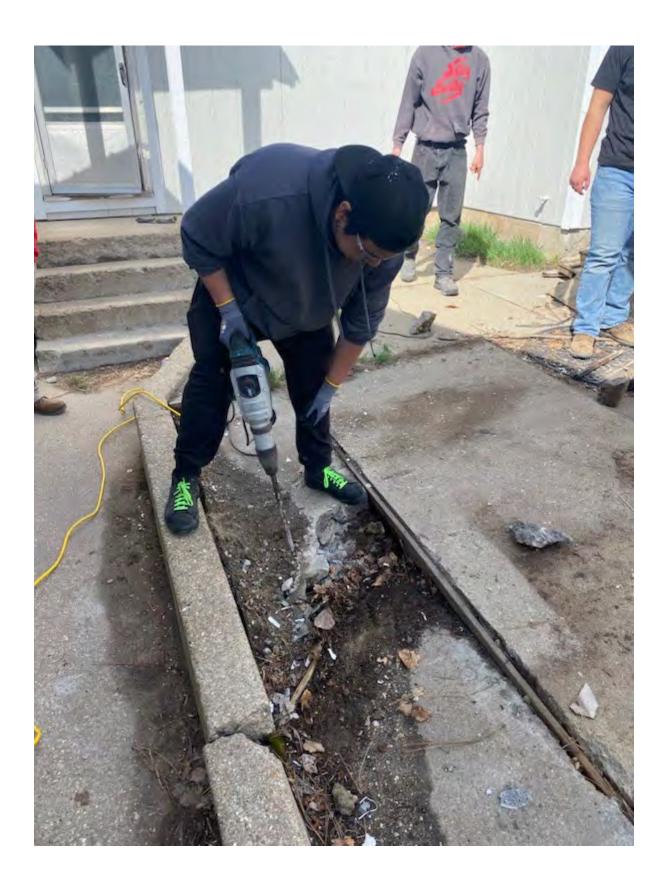

Video Surveillance System Policy		
Approved by: LVCS Board of Directors	Adopted: 5/11/2023	Policy #: 5014

The Board of Directors of Long Valley Charter School ("LVCS" or "Charter School"), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation operating two individual public charter schools, adopts this Policy.

PURPOSE:

The Long Valley Charter School Governing Board authorizes the use of video cameras for the purpose of enhancing school safety and security. Our goals are to promote and foster a safe and secure teaching and learning environment for students and staff, to ensure public safety for visitors to our campuses, and to diminish the potential for personal and organizational loss or destruction of property.

PROCEDURES:

Signage and Notification:

Signage will be posted at school buildings that notify students, parents, staff and the general public of the use of security cameras. Students, parent, and staff will receive additional notification at the beginning of the school year regarding the use of security. Such notification will include, but not be limited to staff and student handbooks.

Camera Placement:

The security camera system is installed in public areas only. These areas include, but are not limited to grounds, exterior entrances or exits to building and property, and large gathering spaces such as cafeteria and lobby. Security cameras will not be used where there is a reasonable expectation of privacy. The Executive Director/ Superintendent will approve the placement.

Viewing:

There will be no monitoring of live recordings, except in the case of a suspected emergency or safety concern. Viewing of recordings is to be performed by authorized personnel that have been expressly designated by the Executive Director/ Superintendent.

No sound is to be monitored or recorded in connection with the video surveillance system.

Student / Personnel Records:

To the extent that any image from the surveillance system creates a student or personnel record, the Executive Director/ Superintendent shall ensure the images that are accessed, retained, and disclosed are in accordance with applicable laws and Board policy.

Release/ Use of Recordings

Release of any recordings will be made only by the Executive Director/ Superintendent as permissible pursuant to applicable laws. Consultation with legal counsel is necessary prior to the release to ensure FERPA requirements are satisfied.

If there is a violation of school policies, rules, or law, information captured through surveillance be used as evidence that may subject them to appropriate disciplinary and legal actions.

Data Storage:

Video recordings are stored in secure, password protected servers to avoid tampering and ensuring confidentiality in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

Recordings will be saved for no less than thirty (30) days.

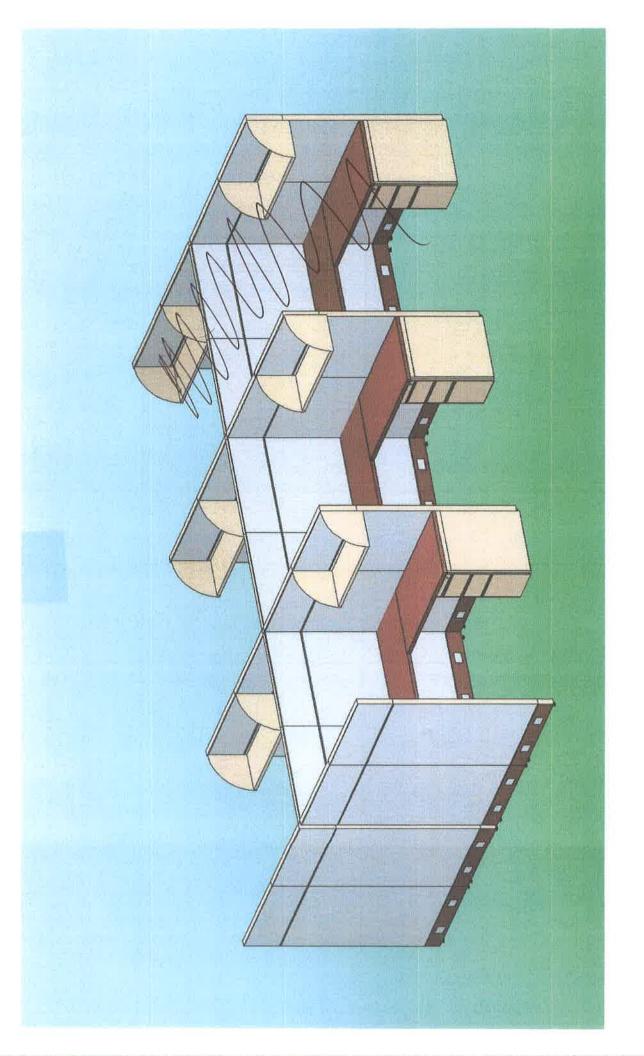
